Ecologica Tredi joins Itelyum The leading group in special waste recovery acquires the Veneto-based company specialised in industrial waste recovery

Pieve Fissiraga (LO), november 7 2022 - Itelyum, a leading Italian company in the circular economy and in particular in special waste recovery, further increases the services offered to industrial supply chains. Today Itelyum finalised the acquisition of 100% of Ecologica Tredi S.r.l., a company active in the treatment and valorisation of industrial waste, both hazardous and non-hazardous, with a consolidated specialisation in the recycling of oil filters, from which iron, aluminium, and contaminated metal packaging are recovered, as well as in the preparation of mixtures for energy valorisation.

Ecologica Tredi has a history of more than twenty years and its plant in Legnago, in the province of Verona, covers over 10,000 square metres and has an authorisation to treat 100,000 tonnes/year.

With this takeover, Itelyum expands its offering in synergy with the other group companies, increasing both the share of waste destined for recovery and its presence in Northern Italy, being able to offer customers and partners an all-round service in the sustainable management of their waste and environmental needs.

The Group now counts 27 companies, employs over 1,150 people and has over 35,000 customers in more than 60 countries worldwide.

"Today, with the entry of Ecologica Tredi into our Group," said Marco Codognola, CEO of Itelyum, "we are continuing the implementation of our strategy, which is aimed at being the Italian reference player for the sustainable management of industrial waste, able to cover the different environmental needs of customers, with a widespread presence in the territory and a vertical offer in the recovery chains, made possible thanks to the synergies between the group's various operating sites.
