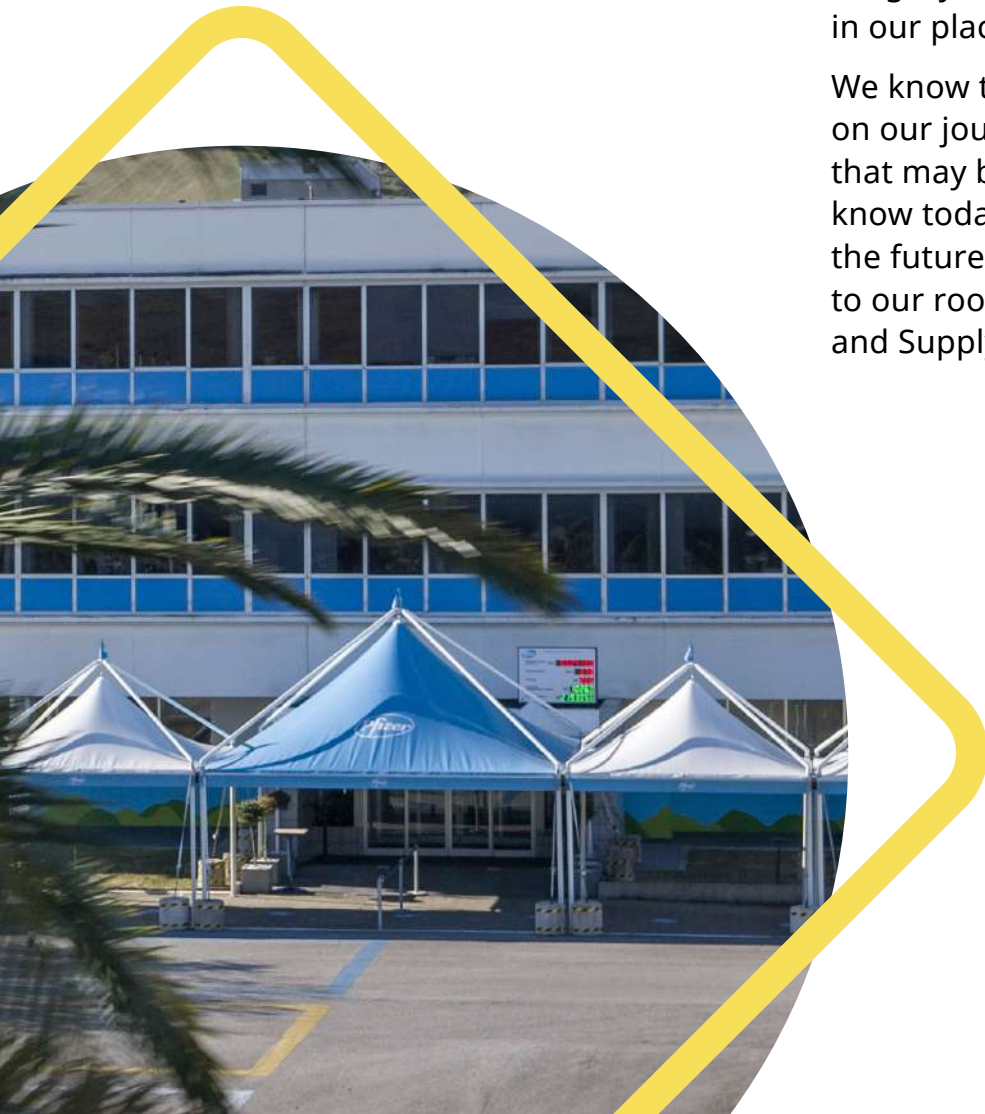
Our vision

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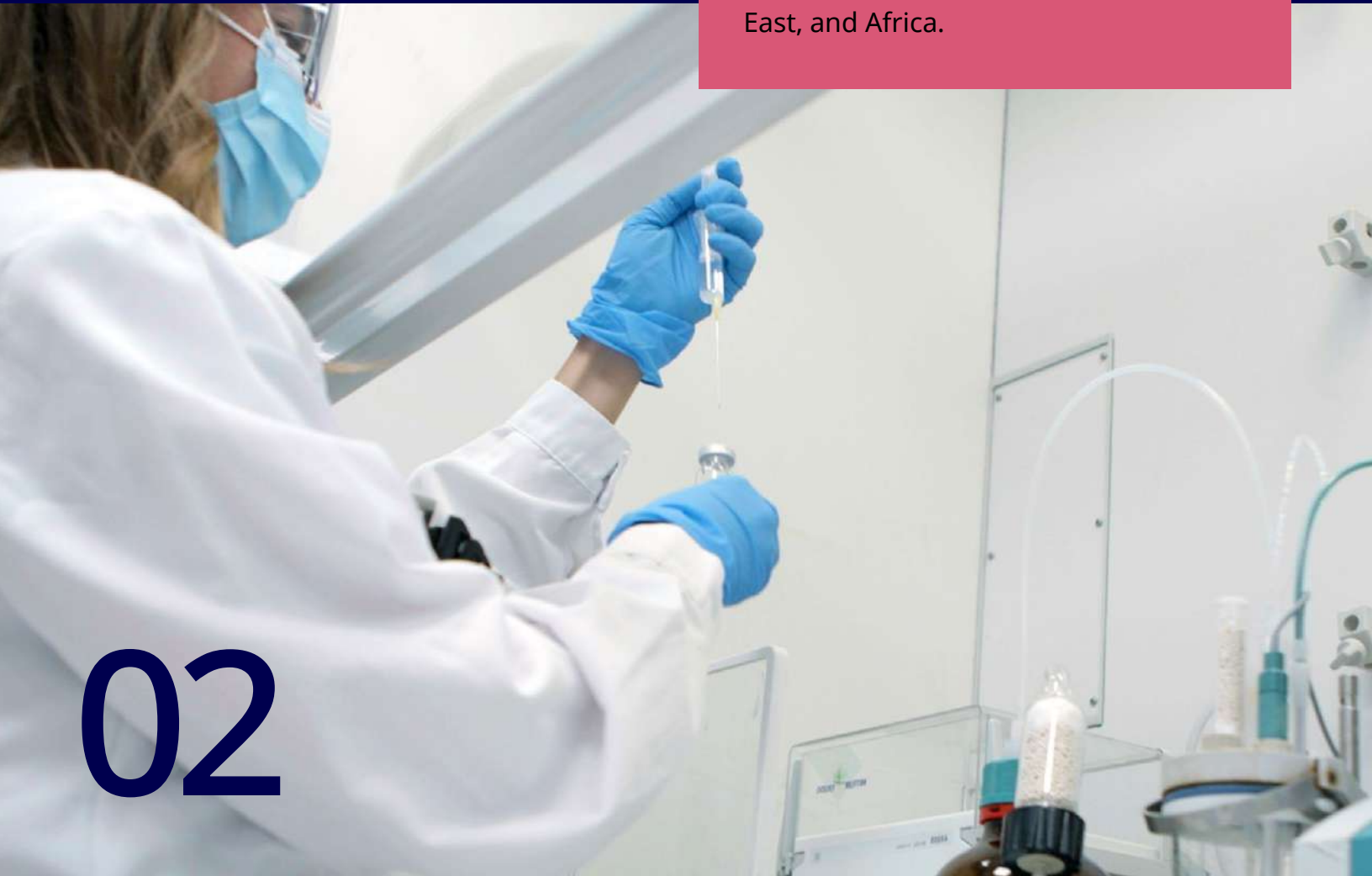
Our mission

Experts in high potency medicines

Approximately 80% of our products are OEB 4-5 produced in our multipurpose area and more than 30% of products are controlled substances. Our entire facility is designed to ensure access and quality control across all phases, from the management of API to the finished goods phase.

Experts in managing complex supply chains

Operating in over 100 markets and supplying over 40 therapeutic products, we excel in complex supply chain management.

No matter what the requirements of your product may be, we help manage batch size ranges from five packs up to more than 400,000 packs.





Manufacturing capabilities

In 2019 Ascoli packaged 4.7B single dose units, of which 75% were manufactured on site.

We have experience in over 40 product families in OEB 1-5 and are licensed for cytotoxic manufacturing and controlled substances. We have expertise in containment and segregation, and offer five segregated

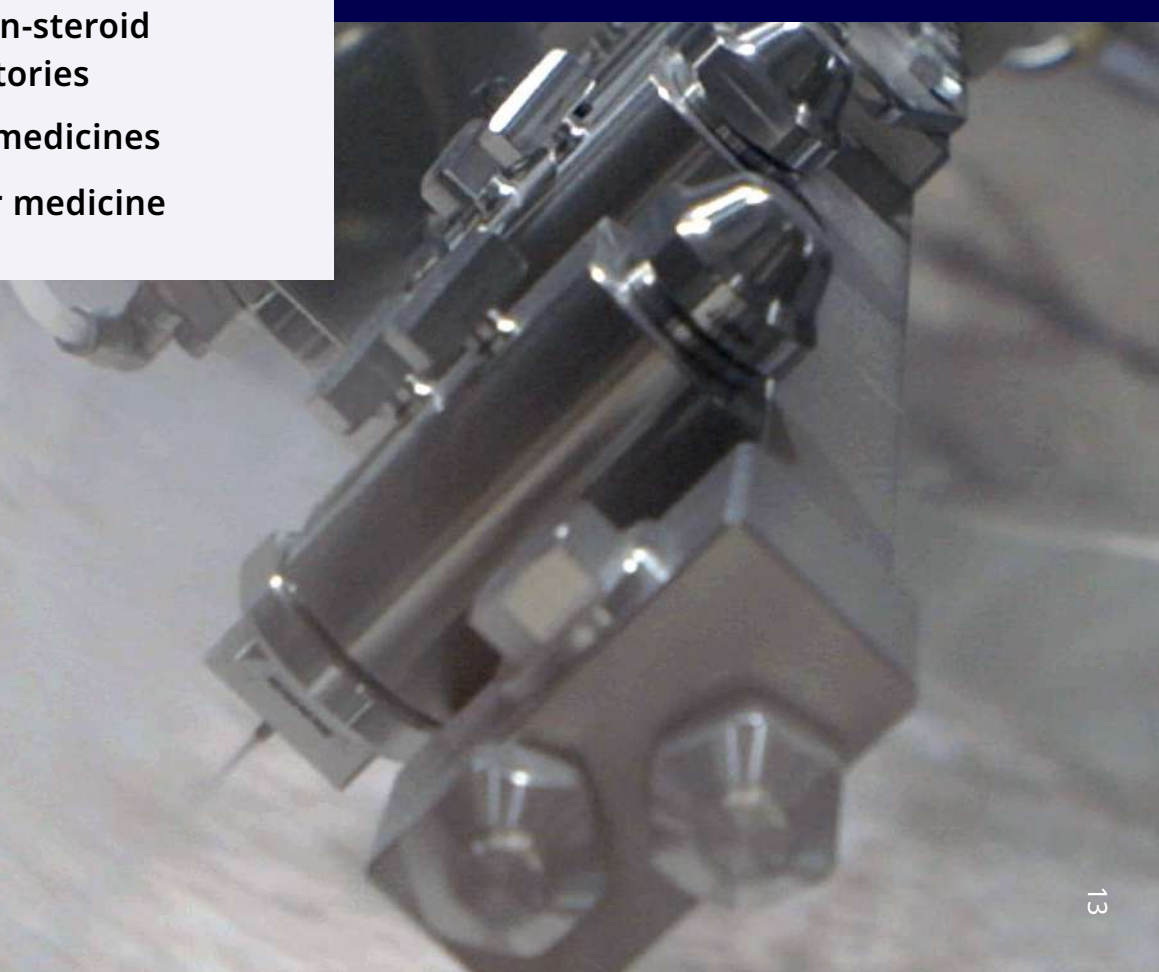
areas for manufacturing and packaging of high potency medicines. We are approved for clinical supply manufacturing and primary packaging.

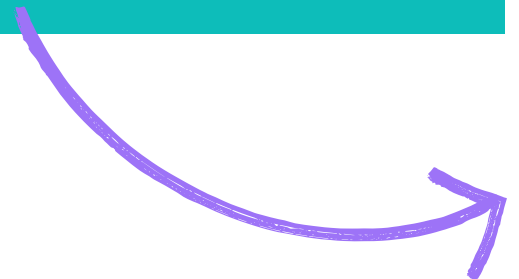


As a global manufacturer, our medicines are destined for locations across the world, with more than 100 markets served.

The global nature of our operations and the high complexity of our medicines means we focus on delivering value through flexibility, innovation and continuous improvement.

Our commitment to quality

At Ascoli, high quality and safety standards are in our DNA. Our on-site Quality team consists of 150 colleagues focused on assuring that we always meet our rigorous standards.

We've walked in your shoes and understand the unique challenges facing your drug product. That's why our Quality Control laboratories conduct thousands of analysis to work toward continued Manufacturing Excellence and total product integrity.

Around 7,550 samples are submitted to process control analysis each year, with close to 3,200 release samples and 3,000 stability samples.

Our commitment to quality is evident in our solid regulatory compliance record, with **zero critical observations** throughout the history of the site.

We receive regulatory inspections from major regulatory bodies such as FDA (USA), ANVISA (Brazil), AIFA (Italy), Turkey, Russia, and MFDS Korea.





Our commitment to innovation

Ascoli is home to an innovation team whose goal is to improve efficiency, safety and our environmental footprint through technology. They look for ideas inside and outside pharma manufacturing to generate process improvements.



Our team has pioneered the use of augmented reality and 3D printing for equipment maintenance. Experts can now inspect equipment remotely and spare parts can be printed efficiently on site.



We have also brought in robots from the automotive industry to facilitate the palletization of products.



Frontline innovation

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In August 2020, we installed and validated new high-tech machinery across one of our packaging lines.

Created by our engineering and manufacturing departments in collaboration with a local supplier, the robotic machine reaches new heights of performance assuring high quality and safety standards.



Packing capabilities

With nearly 50 years of packaging experience, we provide a wide range of options to meet your projects' needs. We offer 26 blister and bottle packaging lines, including high speed, high complexity, and high active equipment.

We can accommodate different demands, with batch sizes ranging from 5 to 400,000 packs and are in full compliance with global serialization and track and trace. Our focus on these capabilities means we are fully dedicated to delivering your product at speed and can flex to meet your needs.



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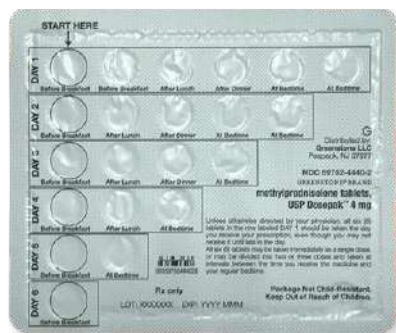

Color Differentiation



Our online printing capabilities allow for a high level of customization. The Hospital Unit Dose packaging on blister products can display the GTIN or the batch number and expiration date, preventing mix-ups and increasing efficiency when each tablet is distributed internally at the hospital. Our color differentiation options can also provide a clearer way to distinguish between medications and dosages.



Our commitment to sustainability

Located in a small town in the Italian countryside, the Ascoli site is the largest of its kind in the surrounding area. We believe it is our responsibility to have a positive impact on the local community and the environment.

Through the use of solar power and cogeneration, Ascoli has reduced CO2 emissions by 52% and water usage by 20% in the last ten years.

In the last eight years we have reduced our total waste by 1/4. We have installed energy efficient water pump systems, cooling tower fans and chillers. Nearly 2/3 of our electric consumption comes from renewable sources. We promote and sustain the application of Forrest Stewardship Council Program for our clients.

The site has a strong connection to the local community. We provide tours to high school and university students and host various projects to give students real-world experience. We participate in local Earth Day volunteer activities, provide relief for natural disaster victims, and support local hospitals and nursing homes.



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We envision Ascoli as a growing tree with deep strong roots. We are passionate about being rooted in this community and aspire to make a positive impact.
